Introduction:

We chose this topic because we thought it would be interesting to know the lucky numbers of students between year 3 and 6's and see how similar it is to their birthdate.

Hypothesis:

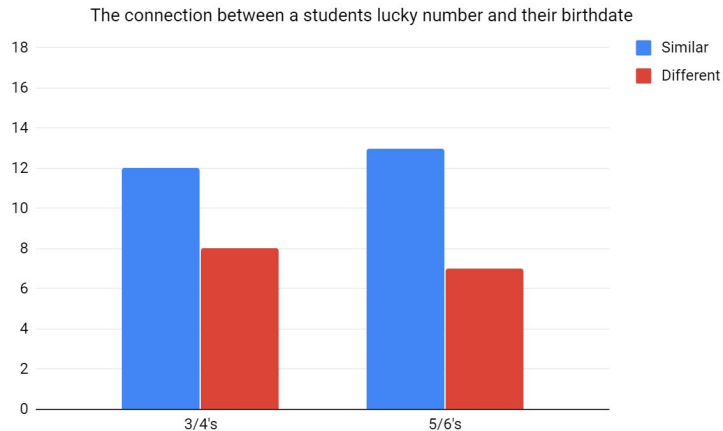
We believe most year 3 to 6 students will choose their birthdate as their lucky number because their birthdays are special to them and want to be proud of their birthday and who they are.

Method:

We surveyed years 3 to 6 students at St Paul's. We asked them the following questions: Age, Gender, Birthday, Favourite number, Second and Third favourite number.

Results:

40 students completed the survey, see bar graph below. In year 3 and 4, 12/20 students had a similar lucky number and birthdate while 8/20 showed no similarity. 13/20 year 5 and 6 students had a related birthdate and lucky number, however 7/20 did not show that.



Discussion:

After we got the data we realised that most students did choose lucky numbers similar that to their birth date. We think they didn't realise that it was similar or close to their birthdate, so next time we would ask them if they chose it because of their birthday.

Conclusion:

There is a strong connection between a students lucky number and their birthdate as they have had this birthdate since they were born so they must love it, because they get gifts!
