Method

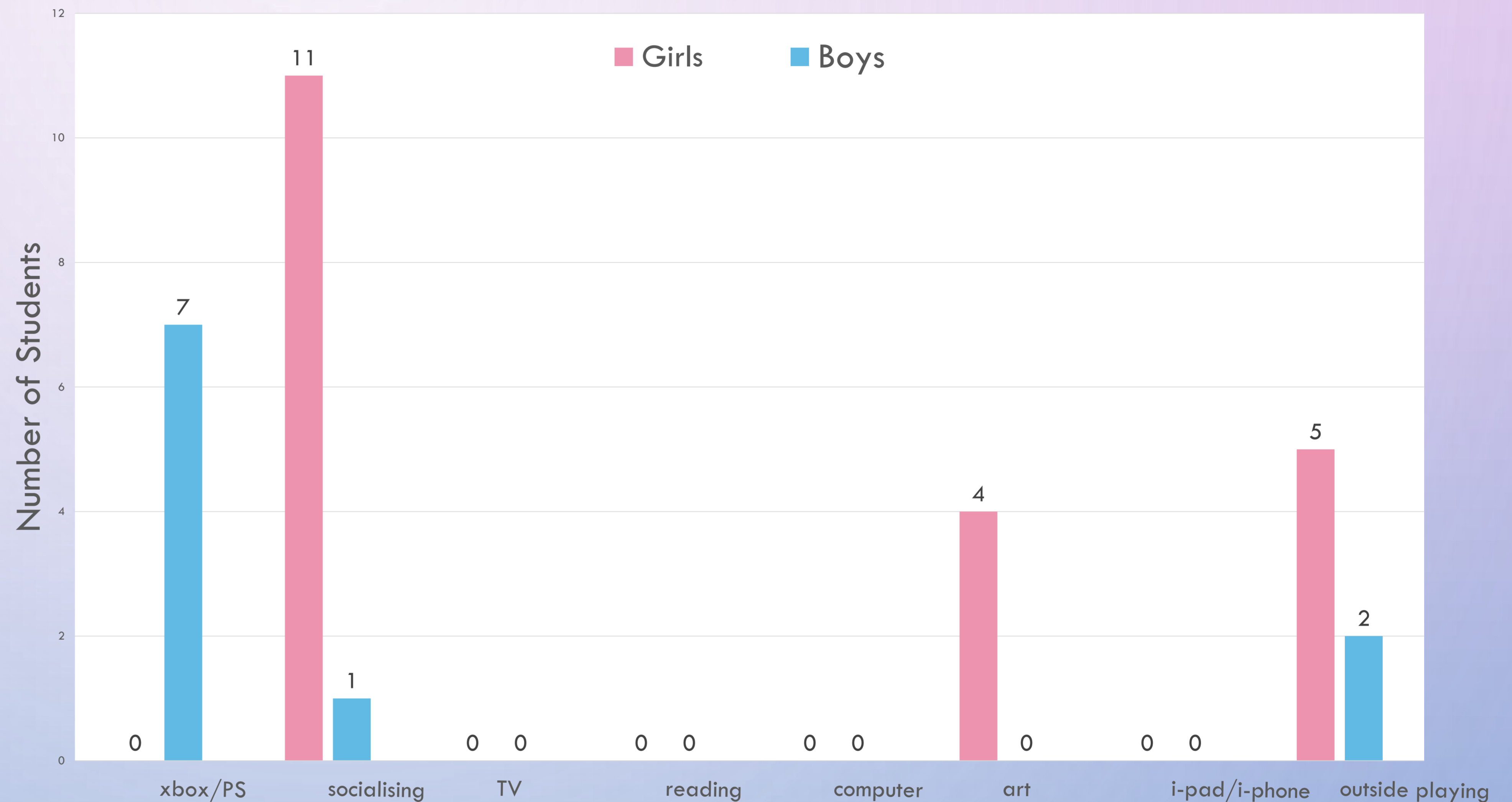
1. To make to a survey
